

ARTICULATION WITH STATE AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENTS



37 MUNICIPALITIES PARTICIPATED IN THE MEETING OF MAYORS IN RIBEIRÃO PRETO HELD BY THE Consortium of municipalities CMM and Apreesp

The Superintendent of FUNASA of the State of São Paulo participated in the Regional Meeting of Municipalities with mayors and municipal technicians in the city of Ribeirão Preto. On the occasion, Anastasi individually assisted 37 municipalities, of which 22 mayors were present, presented their claims and received guidance from FUNASA. Among the main demands of the mayors was the issue of prohibiting municipalities that are part of the Metropolitan Region from signing agreements with FUNASA. On this topic, the Superintendent pointed out that the president of FUNASA at the time, Ronaldo Nogueira, worked personally so that in the voting of the next LOA, this impediment is removed and from 2020 onwards, municipalities are released to enter into their agreements with the entity.

RECOVERING PROGRAM

The CMM held a meeting with all the mayors of the region at Palácio dos Bandeirantes with the then incoming Governor Márcio França to align the proposal for the Resurfacing Program aimed at municipalities.

TECHNICAL CHAMBER OF AGREEMENTS

CONSTANT TRAINING OF MUNICIPALITIES IS THE FOCUS OF THE CMM

The CMM - Consortium of Municipalities of Mogiana has constantly promoted the training of municipal employees to better use the Platform of Agreements of the Federal Government. The Technical Chamber of Agreements has held meetings with the municipalities to provide guidance on fundraising, preparation of proposals, monitoring and accountability of agreements at the state and federal levels. City halls can forward as many servers as they wish to be trained by the Consortium and later these become multipliers of the tool.





RECOVER

CMM Consortium enables municipalities to save R\$250 million in joint purchases

The Consortium has been enabling significant savings to its members through the implementation of Price Registration Minutes. There were several Minutes for joint purchase between the consortium municipalities, which allowed the entities to save on the order of R\$ 250 million between 2018 and 2019. According to Rosatti, the Consortium provides minutes for shared purchase to municipalities of medicines, asphalt mix, equipment rental, asphalt emulsion. In the Price Registration Minutes for the purchase of Asphalt Mass, there were BRL 27 million in savings.



The payments of high amounts in court orders is a topic that has been of great concern to the entity's mayors and has caused a lot of financial difficulty for the municipalities and that is why it was important to create this channel of dialogue between the entities.

The president of the CMM, at the time, Dimar de Brito, presented the preliminary program of the Meeting of Mayors, and later the mayors who were present presented their suggestions for regional elections. The Mayor of Cravinhos, José Carlos Carrascosa dos Santos, did so. present and highlighted that this meeting of mayors will be very important, since there will be face-to-face service "by Federal and State Government technicians, as well as the participation of secretaries and ministers, who will be able to solve various problems in the municipalities right there," he adds. The event promises to be a milestone and, mainly, for the Consortium of Municipalities of Mogiana.



Mayors and representatives of municipalities discussed the current financial situation of the Consortium after three years of work

Mayors and representatives of the cities that make up the Consortium of Municipalities of Mogiana (CMM) participated in a meeting that debated, mainly, the notes of the Court of Auditors and the

next actions.

Created on March 6, 2017, during the Congress of Municipalities of Mogiana held in Ribeirão Preto, the CMM covers 36 municipalities and is enabling significant savings to its members through the implementation of Price Registration Minutes for various products and services.

There were several minutes for joint purchase between the consortium municipalities, which allowed the entities to save on the order of R\$ 250 million between the years 2018 and 2019., for the rental of equipment and machines. were R\$ 3 million and in health. a Minutes were carried out for the purchase of medicines in the amount of R\$ 220 million.

CMM is ranked 1st in Caixa's Public Landfill Notice in a competition with 41 consortia from eight Brazilian states. 41 public consortia were registered, 23 were enabled, covering 304 municipalities in eight states - Bahia, Espírito Santo, Minas Gerais, Mato Grosso, Pernambuco, Rio Grande do Sul, Santa Catarina and São Paulo. totaling 9.9 million people benefited.

Mayors can file their demands and follow up on their agreements in progress with the state and federal governments, on the spot, generating savings in traveling to Brasília.



CONSORTIUM OF MUNICIPALITIES CMM DEFENDS OF THE MUNICIPALITIES IN THE REGION OF FRANCA AND GUARANTEED INCREASE IN COVID BEDS





The CMM – Mogiana Municipalities Consortium defended the municipalities in the Franca region, which are also part of the consortium, and guaranteed an increase in the number of beds in the ICU COVID.

The meeting requested by the interim president of the CMM, Edson Ávallos, was held in partnership with DRS VIII in the city of Franca on December 30, 2020 at 10 am and was attended by the elected mayors and secretaries of the municipalities of Itirapuã, Jeriquara,

Paulista Sponsorship, São José da Bela Vista, Morro Agudo, São Joaquim da Barra, Ipuã, Miguelópolis, Buritizal, Igarapava, Sales Oliveira and Orlândia. The interim president of the CMM opened the work highlighting that the concern, in addition to ensuring care for people in need of beds, ICUs was concomitant with the concern and action for that the region of Franca does not step back from the phase in the next evaluation of the São Paulo Plan that took place on January 7, 2021.

"The preservation of people's lives must always be as a priority, but we can't stay put

crossed waiting and running the risk that the region of Franca could return to the orange phase or

red as it happened before for being

below average, mainly due to the lack of beds, for example, and this requires immediate action", highlighted the president.

The CMM with a group of mayors was already along the week dealing with DRS VIII a way out of the issue such as, for example, the renewal of the agreement with the state of the 10 ITIS beds in the city of Igarapava, an announcement that was confirmed during the meeting, the state renewed the agreement on the day of the meeting orchestrated by the consortium. Another point dealt with to ensure the increase in the number of beds in the region was to supply the 3 respirators that were defective and unusable in the municipalities of Ipuã. The city has 10 COVID beds, but only 7 were suitable for use. The solution occurred during the meeting, the municipality of Morro Agudo, through Mayor Vinicius Cruz Castro, temporarily lent the 3 respirators to Ipuã and with that the region now has 70 ITIS beds. To address health issues in the Franca region, the CMM - Consortium of Municipalities of Mogiana created the **Regional Health Committee and the** ordinance officializing the act was signed during the meeting by the interim president of the CMM, Edson Ávalos, and following the signature the board of the aforementioned Committee was sworn in. where the mavor of Morro

Agudo Vinícius Cruz de Castro remained as president, the mayor of Miguelópolis, Naim Miguel Neto, as vice president, and the mayor of Patrocínio Paulista José Mauro Barcellos as General Coordinator, so the three medical mayors of the region will be in charge of the Committee.

MORE THAN 100 CITIES WERE REPRESENTED AT THE 1ST MEETING OF MUNICIPALITIES OF SÃO PAULO

Presenting tools to ensure improvements in the functioning of services provided to the population, paths in the search for public resources and technical instructions from the State and Federal governments, the 1st Meeting of Municipalities of São Paulo brought together authorities, such as the Minister of Tourism, Marx Beltrão, the minister -head of the Government Secretariat, Antônio Imbassahy, the governor of the State of São Paulo, Geraldo Alckmin, the mayor of Ribeirão Preto, Duarte Nogueira, as well as state secretaries and deputies. More than 500 municipalities were represented in the two days of the event. The initiative is carried out by the CMM (Consortium of Municipalities of Mogiana), with support from the Federal and State Governments and sponsorship from Caixa, Banco do Brasil and Correios. Participating Ministries – At the event, a large structure promoted services to city halls, which were attended by technicians and authorities representing the Ministries of Health, Tourism, Cities, Planning, Education, FNDE, Environment, Social, Funasa, in addition to the secretaries of Housing, Education, Social, Civil House, Sanitation, Environment, Tourism and Agriculture. The initiative represented for all cities in the region, ease of access and agility in these services, which would only be available in Brasília and São Paulo. Panels - Through panels, technicians, secretaries and ministers presented initiatives aimed at innovation, efficiency and greater development in the municipalities, making them stronger in the face of the instability experienced at the present time. Topics such as agribusiness, health, education, environment, tourism, housing, court of accounts, among others were addressed. The mayor of Ribeirão Preto, Duarte Nogueira, who attended the two-day meeting, congratulated the initiative, which guarantees greater support to the municipalities. "This was a challenging year for all of us, mayors, when we took over the city hall at a time of great difficulties. but with dynamism and planning, we are managing to advance, therefore, the importance of effective actions, such as this meeting, which benefits the municipalities", said Nogueira, who highlighted the main actions carried out in the municipality, such as the new investments in the Leite Lopes airport and the Urban Mobility Pac. "These are actions aimed at the development and growth of the entire region," he amended.

Also on Tuesday, 30, after the meeting with the mayors of the Franca region, the interim president of the CMM – Consortium of Municipalities of Mogiana, Edson Ávallos, held the last round of welcome meetings in Ribeirão Preto at the headquarters of the Consortium. to the new managers of that region. According to Ávallos, there were 8 meetings, 4 with the Franca region and 4 with the Ribeirão Preto region, held to receive the elected mayors and present to them the structure, technical support and actions already developed by the CMM Consortium for the benefit of the entity's member municipalities. The Consortium that disputed a Caixa edict with 40 other consortia from municipalities in Brazil and was first placed for the implementation of regional Sanitary Landfills ends 2020 with multiple

achievements and several actions that greatly benefited the consortium municipalities. "We had dozens of actions aimed at political articulation, we resolved several pending issues of our municipalities with the state and federal governments, we constantly trained the employees of each municipality that are part of our entity, and the Price Registration Minutes we offer generated more than R \$800 million in savings to our municipalities", highlighted the president of the CMM.
